

PE and Sports Premium

Background

The government has announced that primary schools are to receive additional money for the purposes of improving the provision of PE and sport so that all primary age pupils develop healthy lifestyles.

Schools are permitted to allocate the sports premium allocation as they see fit, provided that it is used for the purposes of PE and sports. St. Elizabeth's Catholic Primary School will be held accountable for how we have used this additional funding and from September 2013, we are required to publish information on-line about how the sports premium has been spent.

Funding Allocation 2014-15

St. Elizabeth's Catholic Primary School will receive a sports premium allocation of £8,520 plus £5.00 per pupil. This will total £8,925.
